Benefits:

Moisture retention:

The 74% water content provides a moist environment for the eye. More importantly, moisture retention (>98%) ensures stability of optics, oxygen permeability (Dk/t) and lens parameters throughout the day giving the wearer consistent fit, comfort and visual acuity.

These benefits are particularly useful in dry or air conditioned environments.

Surface Treatment Not Required:

Deterioration of surface is often seen with plasma treated lenses. Definitive™ material ensures surface characteristics and wettability remains unchanged throughout, maintaining comfort levels.

Rubbing techniques for lens cleaning can be used as this has no effect upon the untreated surface unlike some plasma treated lenses; rubbing is still recognized as the best option for cleaning soft lenses.

Definitive™ Material Specifications:

- Dk 60 (cm²/s) [ml O₂/(ml x mmHg)]
- Modulus 0.27 Mpa
- Water content 74%
- Non-ionic – does not attract proteins


Wettability:

- A naturally wettable material
- No surface treatment necessary
